But with this comes some friendly advice for those looking to decide...

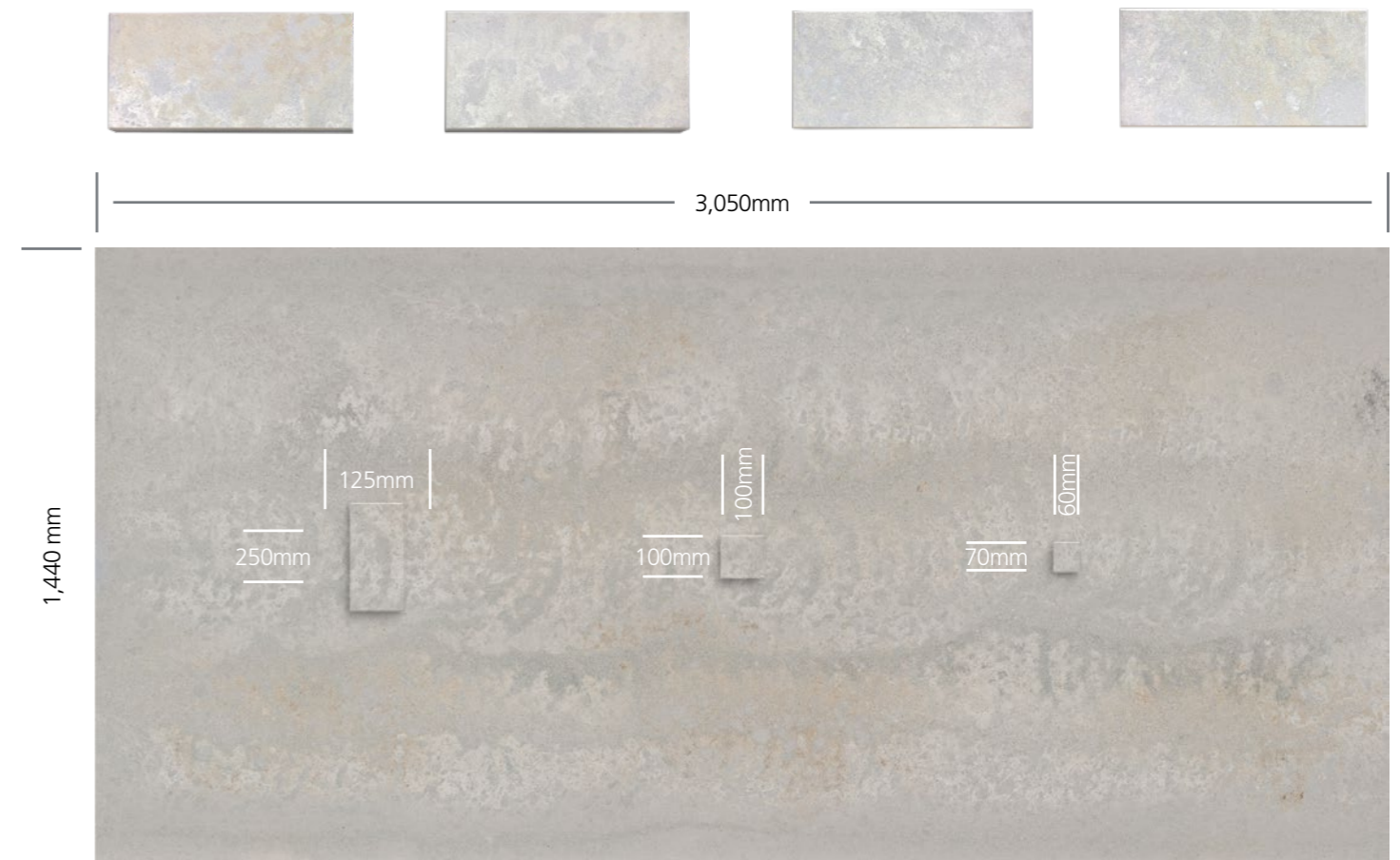
As Caesarstone offers have evolved over the years from monotone to multi-dimensional designs, samples only tell part of the story. For instance, what's displayed on a sample can vary noticeably on colours such as Rugged Concrete, Primordia and Calacatta Nuvo.

Caesarstone typically offer a 60 x 70mm sample to help when choosing a colour, and these are available for order online at our website. You may also see 100 x 100mm and 125 x 250mm samples at kitchen companies and design studios. But as the image alongside highlights, these samples represent only a small area of the overall colour scheme.

The back pages of this book also show a small sample swatch alongside the design across the full slab. Whilst our printed materials are produced to the highest standards in printing, they should be used as an indication of actual product colour, and we'd recommend this mindset when viewing any product brochure, whether it's quartz stone or any other interior surface.

With Caesarstone for nearly a decade, Chief Designer, Mor Krisher, leads a revolutionary approach to design using a far more interpretive process.

“We have been designing surfaces for more than thirty years, and since day one we have intended to push technical and creative boundaries”, says Mor.

“Manufacturing quartz surfaces is a blend of science and art and both aspects hold equal importance.

Beauty catches our eye, but if a product doesn't perform, then we quickly lose patience. We have an incredible

technical R&D team which fortunately means that I can focus my attention solely on the art of our brand.”

With close to 100 products, Caesarstone offers a comprehensive range comprising monochromatic and subtle shades to natural industrial or marble-inspired surfaces. The demand for the natural look continues to grow, and the Caesarstone range with it.

“When we start working on new designs for our Supernatural and Supernatural Ultra products, we take several different qualities from natural stone and combine them. We work on the nuances of the design for many months until we are 100 per cent happy.”

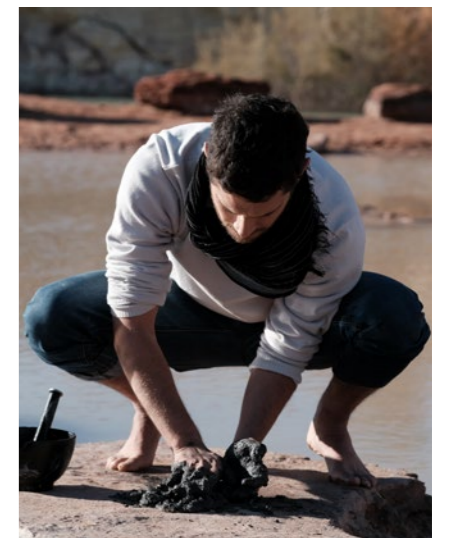
“The result is a beautifully natural-looking product you can't find in nature. We can give consumers and architects, something unique that can't actually be found anywhere else.”

“You have to use your five senses, and be focused on the search for the next trend,” Mor says. “The clues for new trends are everywhere, and you have to be able to collect them all the time. The magic is transforming the trend to a relevant, beautiful product.”

Creating the Dark Collection

Mor's explorative approach inspired the coveted Metropolitan Collection and recently, the evolution and launch of the Caesarstone Dark Collection.

“We've been working on our dark collection for several years,” says Mor. “We decided to go outdoors and take a journey to the desert to observe nature and explore the organic materials there.”



The transition from day to night opened up a well of new ideas and inspiration for Mor's team.

"Night changes our perception of what's around us. We wanted to see how various stones hold different colours and hues at night. Dark colours can be dramatic, bold and mysterious, or warm and comforting".

"Our senses heighten in the dark and with darkness comes a world of calm and comfort as we return to our homes at night," Mor explains.

Dark tones are the entire rich world of inspiration rekindling designers' interest in marbles and slate, natural tactile materials that evoke a sense of warmth.

Introducing his captivating new designs, Black Tempal, and Empira Black, Mor describes the attributes of each.

"The Black Tempal design has a complex composition of mineral-like layers. It captures the qualities of natural stone like travertine and slate. Warm whites expand across the slab in contrast to its black base."



Inspired by the authentic characteristics of natural forms, Mor says, "Empira Black is a creative interpretation of dark marble. It's a design beyond time and trend with all the mystery of the dark stone. Its dark base composed of a rich deep black beautified by fine white natural veins."

New product development at Caesarstone takes time – and many prototypes explains Krisher.

"After we develop the concept, we start the search for the right colours," he says.

"The colours must engage each other and complete one another. Then we start the process of the hunt for the master slab. We are looking for the perfect combination of layers, colours and structure that best represents the

concept."

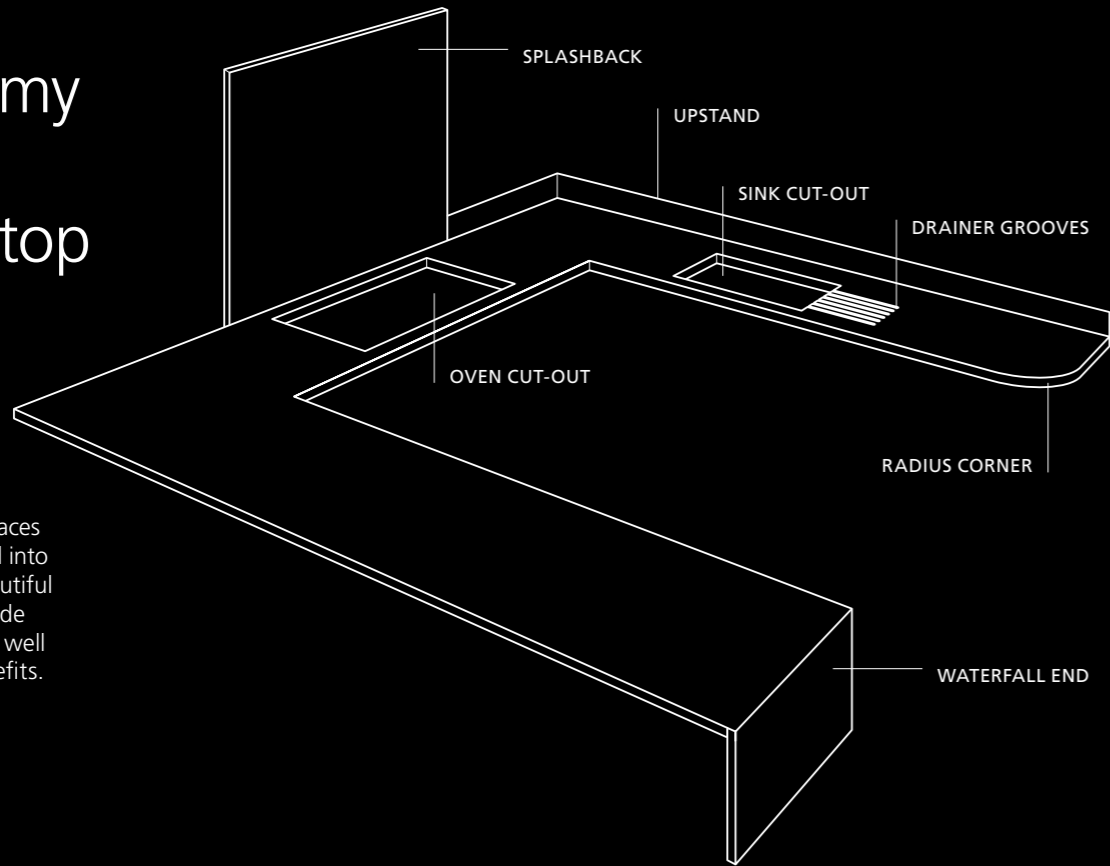
Mor wants to add colour, texture and complexity to modern kitchen designs.

"I think the trend of sterile kitchens can't continue," he says. "Caesarstone doesn't like to advertise kitchens today without people. It's no longer a benchtop with cabinets. It's a space where food and people are joined together for dialogue. The kitchen is a playground for us to create joyful moments for our families and friends. It's a place where things happen, where people live."

Mor concludes that the design process is "an evolution – one thing leads to another. People are becoming bold in their choices. For me, it's an opportunity to create more. There is always so much

more to discover and bring to our customers."

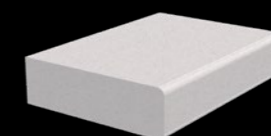
Edge profiles

Surface edges can be custom-designed by your stonemason to create a variety of styles and thicknesses. Professional stonemasons will generally finish 20mm bench top edges with a minimum 2mm profile. To protect and prolong the life and performance of your Caesarstone quartz surface, we recommend a rounded edge finish with the minimum radius of 3 – 4mm. The minimum radius for edge profiles both reduces the risk of chipping and increases the safety of the surface edges for your space. Getting the details right is critical to design success. This diagram shows a number of different edge finishes to suit traditional and contemporary kitchen styles.

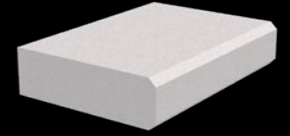

Cutting a slab for a U-shaped kitchen

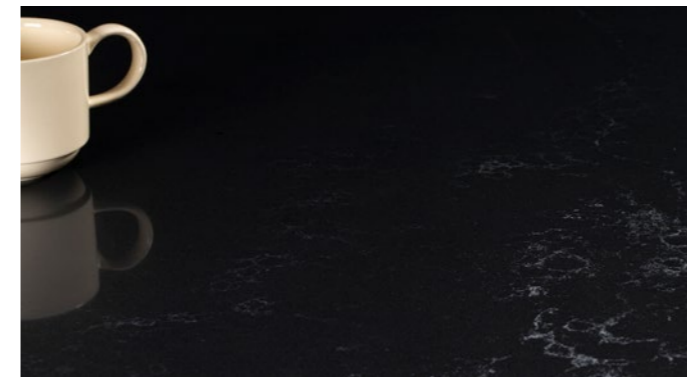

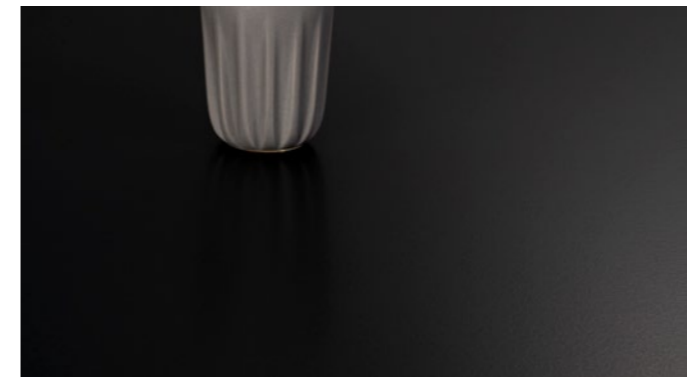

Care & Maintenance

Designed to Endure the Everyday

Caesarstone surfaces require very little maintenance to keep them looking like new. For everyday routine cleaning of Caesarstone we recommend wiping the surface with warm soapy water (a mild detergent) and a clean damp cloth, or use our Caesarstone Spray Cleaner. Do not use the cloth you use to wash the dishes, as it may transfer oils and other contaminants to the Caesarstone surface. As Caesarstone is virtually non-porous, it will never require polishing or sealing.

Tough? Yes. Indestructible? No.

As with any surface, Caesarstone can be permanently damaged by exposure to strong chemicals and solvents that undermine its physical properties. Do not use products that contain trichlorethane or methylene chloride, such as paint removers or stripper. Avoid all contact with highly aggressive cleaning agents like oven cleaners that have high alkaline/pH levels. Should the surface be accidentally exposed to any of these damaging products, rinse immediately with water to neutralize the effect.

Heat Resistance

Caesarstone is heat resistant, however like all stone materials; Caesarstone can be damaged by sudden and rapid surface temperature changes. A good rule of thumb is that if your hand cannot tolerate the level of heat of an item to be placed on the surface for more than a few seconds, then the heat source is too high. Therefore we always recommend placing hot pots, oven trays and fry pans directly from the oven or hot plate onto a wooden chopping board or cork mat.

We also recommend that all electrical cooking appliances such as electric frying pans and slow cookers are also placed on a wooden chopping board.

Food Preparation

We always recommend cutting on an appropriate cutting board and never directly on the Caesarstone surface to avoid blunting kitchen knives or damaging the surface of your benchtop.

Caesarstone's specially formulated range of cleaning products – our Spray Cleaner and Cream Cleanser - offers both everyday as well as thorough cleaning solutions designed to keep your quartz surfaces looking their best. Both are available to purchase through our online store.

Rough Surfaces

Caesarstone offers a range of designs with a technologically advanced surface we call 'Rough', which is different to our Concrete (or honed/matte finish). Despite the 'rough' impression, it's remarkably easy to care for and maintain. It should be noted that the low reflective surface of Rough may be more susceptible to showing everyday marks and spills compared to a polished surface. With all our surfaces, we recommend regular cleaning to help remove any visible marks and stains.

Concrete & Natural Finishes, Dark Colours

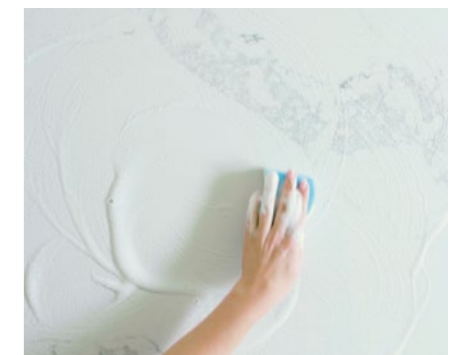
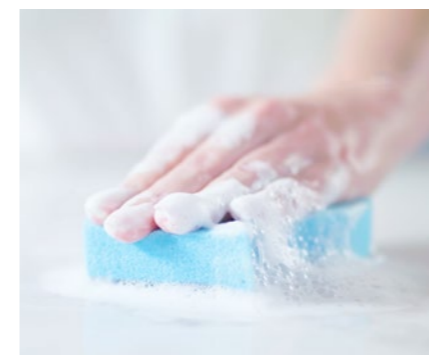
Caesarstone® Concrete and Natural finish designs carry the same stain and scratch resistance as our polished surfaces, never require sealing and are simple to clean.

However, these two finishes do not disguise marks and fingerprints as well as the polished designs, meaning more regular cleaning may be required.

The above also applies to dark and black colours in our range. Whilst Caesarstone is scratch resistant, like all surfaces it is not totally scratch-proof. Black and dark surfaces can show scratches more readily than a lighter surface.

For Tough Stubborn Stains

Use the recommended process for our Caesarstone Cream Cleanser, but apply two drops of liquid gel bleach onto the sponge prior to foaming up the benchtop surface. Then use the cleaning method as described in our latest Care & Maintenance manual and web page.
